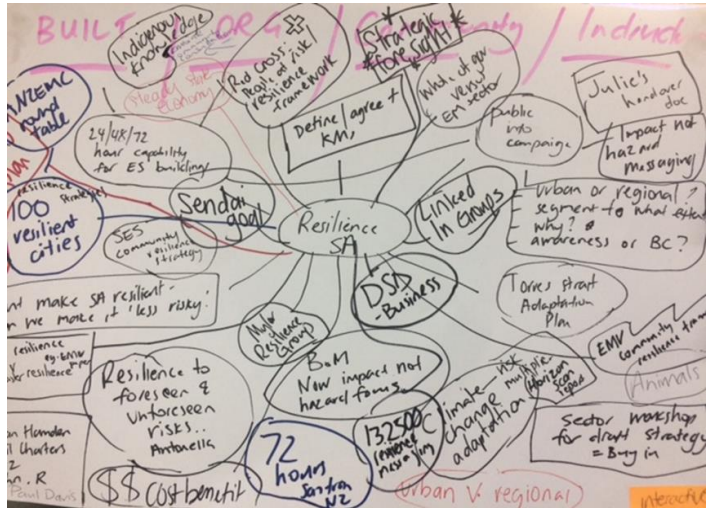

If a community is not resilient they are at greater risk during an event and their recovery is delayed

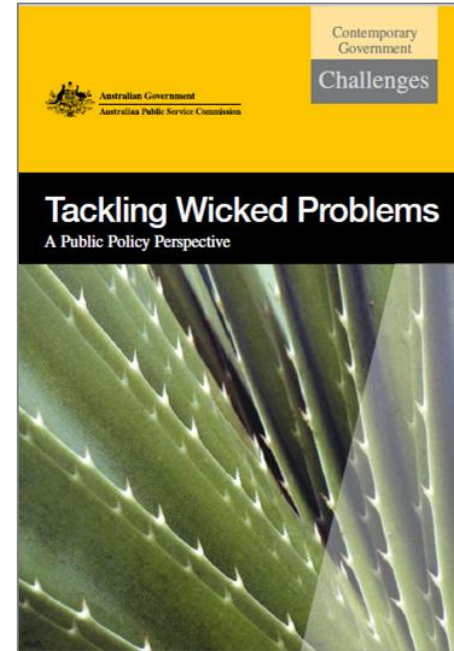


Wicked Lab

 - Systemic Innovation Lab Methodology

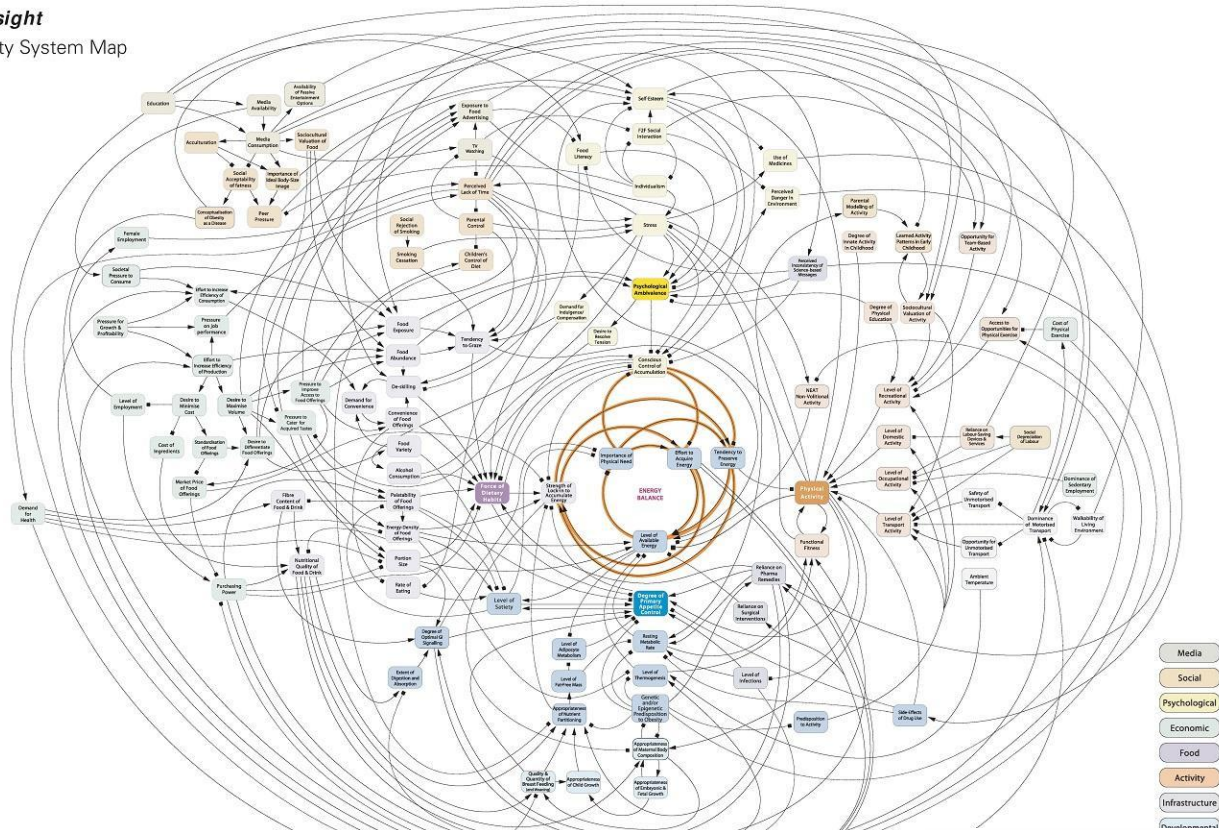
Characteristics of Wicked Problems

- Complex social policy problem
- Multi-causal
- Many interdependencies
- Different stakeholders have a different understanding of what the problem is and they therefore have conflicting goals
- No clear solution
- Attempts to address them often leads to unforeseen consequences due to their multi-causality and interdependency
- They adapt
- They are context specific
- **Government has a policy position**

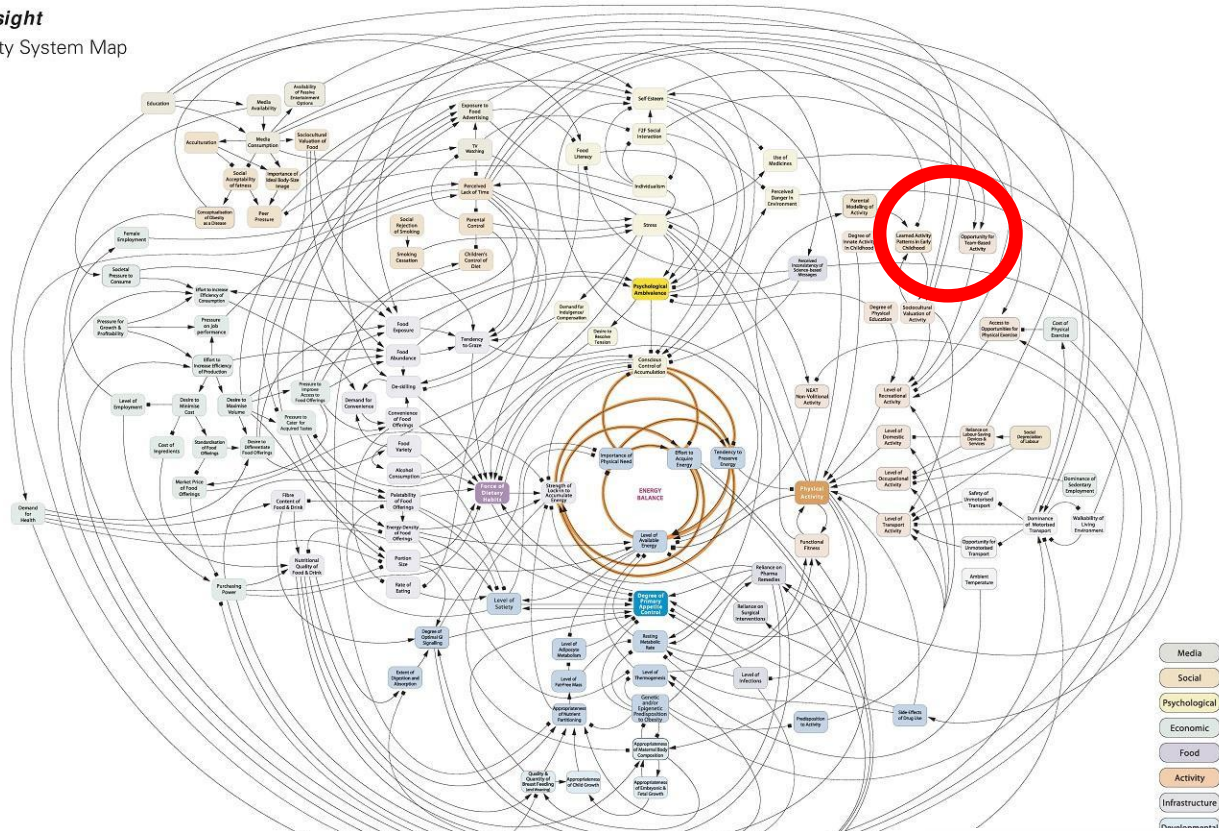

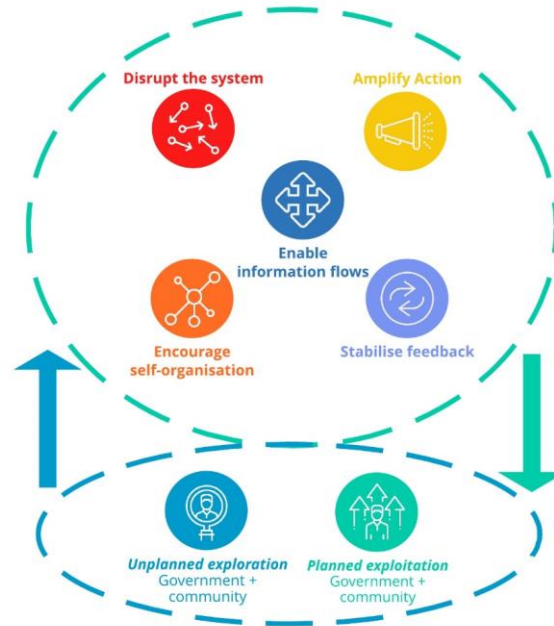

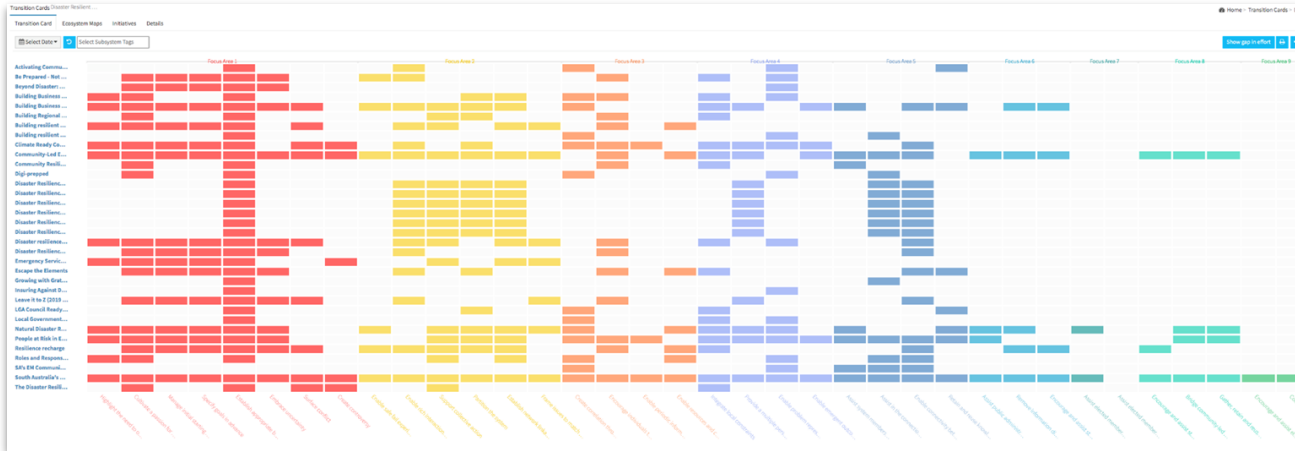
